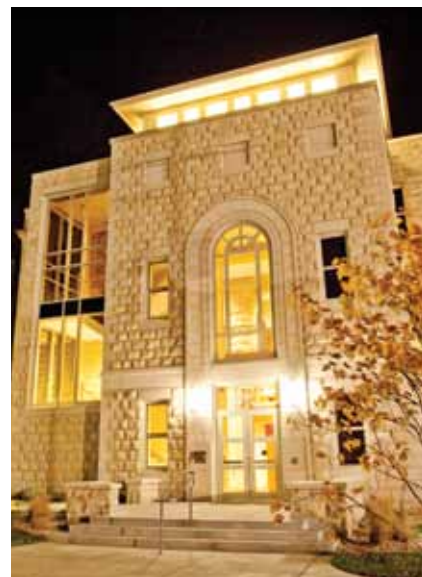
the way are Brian Powers, President; Robyn Kejr, Vice President; Eric Schneider, Secretary; and Alli Woods, Treasurer.

CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AFTER HOURS—For the first time ever, MCC hosted the Chamber of Commerce and brought more than 150 community business leaders to campus on August 19. After touring nearly-complete Jolliffe Hall, everyone was served a hamburger cook-out in the Campus Center.

SEPTEMBER 2009

FALL 20TH DAY showed that enrollment was down. A headcount of 345 is the fourth lowest fall headcount in the past ten years. These numbers included the start up semester of the Online Degree Completion Program which had 7 students participating.

SEPTEMBER 24TH— Oh! What a day in the history of the college! It all started at 7:30 a.m. with the 7th Annual Leadership Breakfast featuring Dr. Don Wilson and 167 community leaders in the Campus Center. It was the largest attendance we have ever had and the atmosphere was electric. As breakfast ended at 9:00 a.m. MCC along



with the Chamber of Commerce hosted a ribbon-cutting ceremony on the south entry of Jolliffe Hall and again, the attendance was over 150. At 11:00 a.m. the student body was first to participate in an event inside the new building with a leadership panel discussion featuring three from Christ's Church of the Valley. Dinner was held at 5:00 p.m. in the Campus Center for significant donors and partners in the Jolliffe Hall project. The dedication service at 7:00 p.m. was standing room only with more than 350 in attendance. Alumni, church representatives, students, and other friends of the college were all on hand to worship and pray together for the future ministry and training that would happen within these walls again. A reception followed on the third floor and guests enjoyed self-guided building tours. Although there was not an official count taken overall, it is believed that throughout the day, more than 650 different individuals celebrated this milestone with the college.

HIGHLIGHTS OF 2009-2010

10TH ANNUAL GOLF CLASSIC—September 25 was a beautiful day on the Colbert Hills Golf Course for the 121 golfers who were part of our scramble. The winning team shot -16 and was from Christ's Church of the Valley in Peoria, AZ. The drawing for the full set of PING clubs, one of the most anticipated highlights of the day, went to Stan Stark of Pratt, KS.

MORE THAN 115 family members participated in fellowship with their students during Family Weekend, September 25-26. Athletic games, Famous Dave's BBQ, brunch, Jolliffe Hall tours, and a dessert bar were the scheduled events, but the biggest draw for most families to come is time to hang out with their students in their natural MCC habitat.

OCTOBER 2009

KERUSSO DAYZ COMMUNITY—In a two-day period of time (Oct. 15-16) over 120 students and a few faculty and staff served 14 ministries/organizations throughout the Manhattan area. The teams completed 565 hours of service at the following locations: Bethlehem Revisited, Big Brothers & Sisters, Boys & Girls Club, Eisenhower Middle School, Flint Hills Bread Basket, Flint Hills Christian School, Flint Hills Community Clinic, Habitat for Humanity, Hope Ranch, Kansas Youth for Christ, Life Choice Ministries, Manhattan Emergency Shelter, Manhattan High School, and Sunset Cemetery.



THE 4TH ANNUAL WESTERN FELLOWSHIP OF PROFESSORS AND SCHOLARS was the first special event held in Jolliffe Hall. Organized by Professor Mark Alterman and held October 16-17, about 30 scholars participated. The conference promotes research, discussion, and

academic fellowship on issues relating to the Christian faith. Events included keynote sessions by Dr. Ben Witherington III of Asbury Seminary plus 12 special interest topics presented by other theology faculty.

ALUMNI GAMES, held annually in the fall for men's and women's basketball, men's and women's soccer, and volleyball bring fierce competition between the current team and alumni of all ages. Games are followed with a special food fellowship for the alumni families in the Campus Center.



BUSINESS AS MISSION SUMMIT was held October 25-26. MCC alum Dr. Ed Bond, Chair and Associate Professor, Dept of Marketing, Bradley University; Denny Fulk, Director of Business Strategy, Keyway Associates, a branch of Christian Missionary Fellowship; Dr. Rob Edleston, President, Manhattan Area Technical College; Steve Edwards, Church Planter; John Hendee; MCC alum Dr. Les Palich, Associate Professor and Associate Director of the Entrepreneurship Program, Baylor University; and MCC personnel: Kevin Ingram, Rusty Thornley, Dale Levering, and Randy Ingmire.

3RD ANNUAL EDWARDS LECTURESHIP took place on October 26-27 with John Hendee, founder and executive director of Project Hope International. John spoke on "building bridges" to reach the world with the gospel. Special student sessions were also held during the daytime on the topic of "Dragon Slayers", the topic of a new book being written by John. Evening keynote sessions are free and open to the public, but John also addressed the students in dorm devos, regular chapel services, and in some classes. The college is grateful to the Arthur Edwards family and the gifts they have made to honor his commitment and service in ministry and to endow this lectureship.

WOMEN'S SOCCER TEAM was crowned the National Champions for the NCCAA Division II for the first time in school history.

1ST ANNUAL MCC NOW ALUMNI CAMPAIGN—The goal was to make a phone connection with MCC graduates and invite them to be a part of the momentum generated in the MCC Now Campus Campaign and help provide new furnishing that were needed to Jolliffe Hall. The average gift was \$52.89 and the campaign raised more than \$3,000 which was enough to purchase two plasma-screen TVs and an AV teaching podium for Jolliffe Room 202.

THE NATIONAL MISSIONARY CONVENTION was held November 19-21 in Peoria, IL. MCC took part as an exhibitor and sent a group of 23 students and 4 adults.

PART-TIME PROFESSORS RECEIVE DOCTORATE—Two professors who have been instructors at MCC for more than 10 years completed their PhD. Dr. Doug Wallace received his doctorate in sociology. Dr. Dale Levering received his doctorate in agricultural economics.

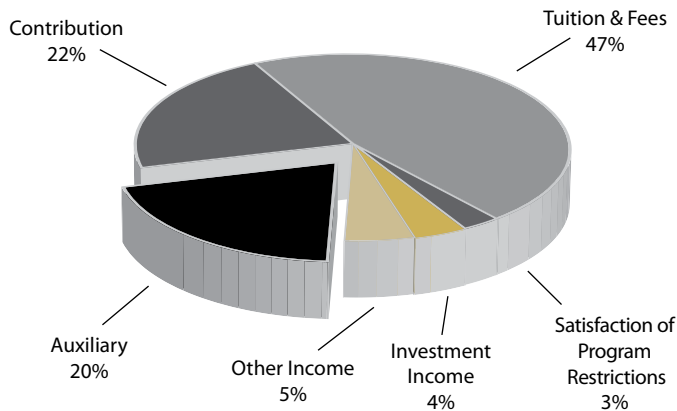

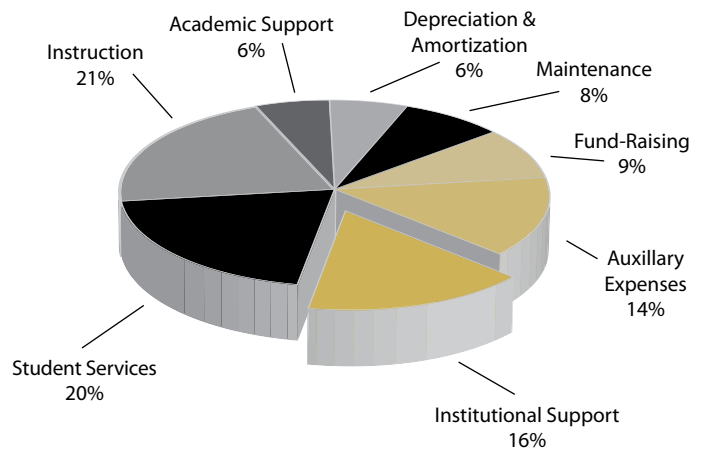

HIGHLIGHTS OF 2009-2010

TIMOTHY DAYS SCHOLARSHIP EVENT—61 students representing seven different states interviewed for the scholarship.

2ND ANNUAL MCC NOW CAMPUS CAMPAIGN—A combination of students and faculty raised \$5,765 to purchase some additional equipment which will complete the Jolliffe Hall sound system. Overall there was 44% participation. Faculty and staff led the way with 79.7%, followed by sophomores 47%, juniors 41.2%, seniors, 38.1%, freshmen 33.3%, and LEAD 23%.



FEBRUARY 2010

20TH DAY FOR THE SPRING SEMESTER—Total headcount is 304 students and the retention rate from fall '09 to spring '10 for full-time students is 86%.

THE CITY OF MANHATTAN passed the ordinance to turn the on-street parking on Laramie and 16th streets into an orange parking zone. MCC controls the majority of the permits allowed for this parking. This access to more parking for the MCC family is a real blessing and will free up more spaces in the lot behind the Campus Center for students.

TWO SHORT VIDEOS have been put together that can be shown in church presentations and/or viewed from the website and on YouTube. One gives a general overview of student life here at MCC and the other is a summary of the Jolliffe Hall construction project including the grand reopening of the building and how it is currently being used.



"AMAZING GIRLFRIENDS"
33rd Annual Woman's World, February 26-27, was an amazing sold-out weekend! Registrations were 813, a 22% increase over 2009 and the second largest the conference has ever had. 93% of the women came from Kansas, but 8 other states were also represented: Oklahoma, Nebraska, Missouri, Texas, Indiana, Iowa, Arizona, and Tennessee. About 30% said that this was their first time to attend Woman's World.

MARCH 2010

THE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TEAM came in 5th place at the NCCA National Tournament. Brianna Helfrich was named 1st Team All-American and Kristy Reigle was named Scholar-Athlete. Women's Basketball Coach Larry Olson was named the Regional Coach of the Year. The men's team fell short in their bid to make the National Tournament but several individuals received recognition. Mike Williams was named 1st Team All-Region and 2nd Team All-American. Jordan Strom and Kenny Park were named 2nd Team All-Region and Jared Hart was named Scholar-Athlete.

DRAMA TEAM "A DIFFERENT VIEW" presented "Outside Looking In", a completely student-led drama production that used seven short skits to talk about the existence of God, what is freewill, why God allows evil, what role does prayer play, the sacrifice God made for all on the cross, temptation, and heaven and hell. It was a 35-minute play (partially written by our students) that showed how an agnostic newspaper reporter could begin to understand who God is and how He wants to be involved in his life. It provided an excellent opportunity for MCC to offer something for the community that would focus their thoughts on God's sacrifice leading up to Easter.



HIGHLIGHTS OF 2009-2010



SPRING BREAK MISSION TRIPS for 33 students and one staff person accomplished a combined total of 2,000 hours of Christian service. Student-led teams served in five different locations: Mexico City, Mexico; Lakeview Christian Camp, Stockton, KS; Safelace, Chicago, IL; The Bridge, Joplin, MO; and One Mission, Rocky Point, Mexico.

“GOD BRINGS OUT THE BEST IN YOU” is a new bulletin insert that can be requested by churches or used by traveling MCC staff. It gives a simple overview of student life and the programming available at MCC.

APRIL 2010

ERIC SANFORD traveled with the Rotary Club of Eastern Kansas to Brazil. Over a three-week period, he visited some of their higher learning institutions and spread the Word.

MANHATTAN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE BUSINESS SHOWCASE—MCC participated in an exhibition of Manhattan area businesses. The evening event gave the college a chance to highlight their mission of Christian leadership training as well as build upon the visibility that the college has enjoyed this academic year with the successful Jolliffe Hall events.

MCC PURCHASED a series of 15-second commercials from KSNT, a Topeka based TV station and they were on campus to shoot footage. The college produced three different commercials each focusing on something different: general MCC mission, adult education for local degree completion program, and online degree completion opportunities.

CURRICULUM REVIEW CONTINUES

What do we want our students to know? What do we want our students to be able to do? Who do we want our students to be? These are the questions that the faculty, administration, staff, and leaders in the brotherhood have been working to answer in a collaborative effort since 2008. The faculty is continuing to carefully analyze all of the input they have received and how the current curriculum matches up with those outcomes. Even though it is continuing to be a time-consuming process, everyone is confident that the process will ultimately benefit the student and the future needs of the church.

MAY 2010

THE 2010 MCC NOW campus committee hosted a Worship Night entitled “Super Sound System Sundae Celebration.” Everyone was encouraged to come and enjoy the new sound and light system that had been installed in the chapel as a result of their gifts. Brownie sundaes were served after the service.

CRUSADER BASEBALL PLAYERS, Mike Foster (2B), Eammon Bradley (OF), and Brandon Roth (P) were named 1st Team All-Americans at the NCCAA National Tournament. After becoming regional champs, the team finished 3rd place at nationals.

MCC CONFERS 2,000TH DEGREE—The college has trained more than 2,000 graduates to penetrate the world with the gospel. MCC celebrated its first 1,000 graduates after being in existence almost 70 years, but it has taken only 13 years to reach the second 1,000 graduates. This year’s class of 90 graduates represents a wide span of ministry interests that are going many various directions to reach the world for Christ. We were honored to have the President at Kansas State University, Dr. Kirk Schulz, address the graduates this year. And it was unique to see that over ten percent of the class graduated with dual-degrees, one from MCC and the other from KSU.

JUNE 2010

CHURCHES IN THE AREA that are between ministers or are too small to have a regular minister contact the college for help filling their pulpit. A combination of faculty, staff, students, alumni, and friends of the college serve in this capacity. We filled 253 request this year which was 19% ahead of the previous year.

LEARNING IN THE 21ST CENTURY

Manhattan Christian College has made a commitment to global ministry leadership training. MCC's regionally accredited distance education degrees in Biblical Leadership and Management and Ethics are designed to provide busy adults the opportunity and flexibility to finish a Bible-based education that will enhance their careers and ministry.

B.S. in Biblical Leadership is designed to enhance a student's current career in the local church and/or a parachurch ministry as well as helping them to complete their bachelor degree.

B.S. in Management and Ethics offers students the opportunity to complete a business degree with an emphasis on biblical ethics.

The primary goal of these Bible and ethics courses is to improve a person's ability to study and understand the Bible and apply proper principles of interpretation

Online students may take any two of the distance education courses during each 8-week term, and there are two 8-week terms per semester.

Generally, students spend an average of 12-15 hours per week on a class. You may also take specific courses to increase biblical knowledge, provide additional training, or receive continuing education credits for ACASI teacher certification.

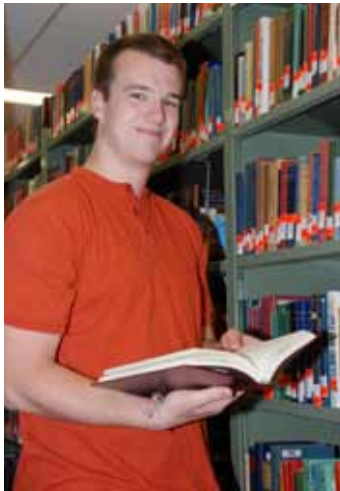
